

MAS302: Confidentiality Agreement

1. All students are required to adhere strictly to the individual schools' confidentiality agreements.
2. All students will respect the confidentiality rights of all members of the school community. The only exception to this is with any allegations or suspicions or cause for concern regarding child abuse. Volunteers are expected to make themselves familiar with the individual school's Child Protection Policy and follow it rigidly.
3. Names of pupils will not be identified in support group supervision sessions or in any written assessment. Pseudonyms will be chosen and used instead when speaking or writing about pupils.
4. Nothing discussed in support group supervision sessions will be spoken about outside the group in a manner which identifies any pupil.
5. Group members and the supervisor will remind each other of the confidentiality agreement as the need arises.
6. It is inappropriate to discuss individuals or incidents that have occurred whilst mentoring/tutoring unless in a formal supervised setting.
7. Confidentiality of information about schools, children and their families is paramount.
